Wednesday is our busiest day.

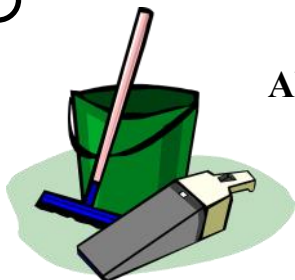
