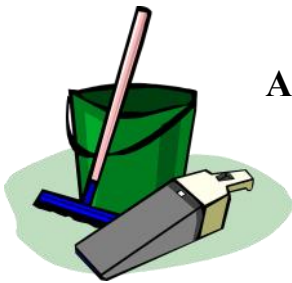
Tuesdays we will peel, cook, rice, and mix.
