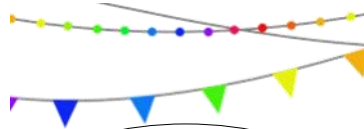

A space in the fellowship hall will be set up to bring in donations for the nearly new sale starting in June.

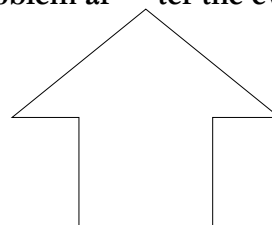
