Monetary offerings should be marked as "Food Shelf" so your

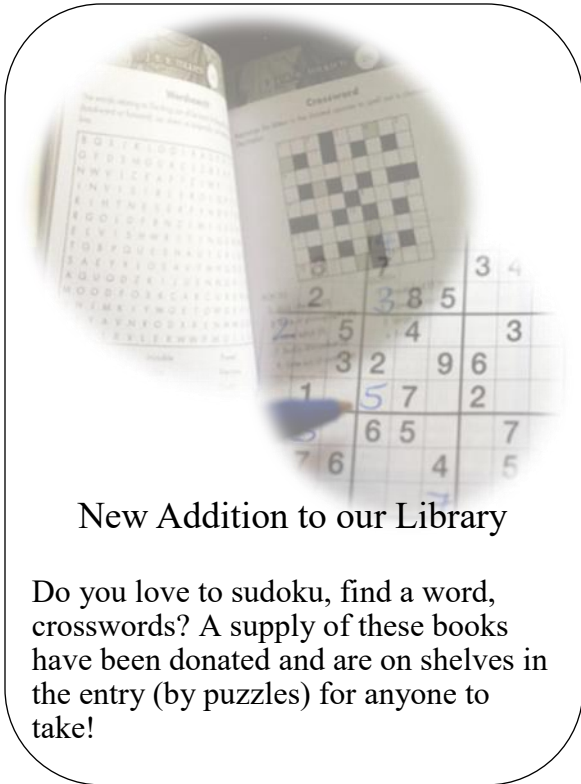
donation can all get sent to the Food Shelf as one large group donation. We also will be collecting food items on a table in the narthex. When we work together, we can make a great impact.
