Handling all the unsold items can create a problem after the event. Thank you for your consideration.

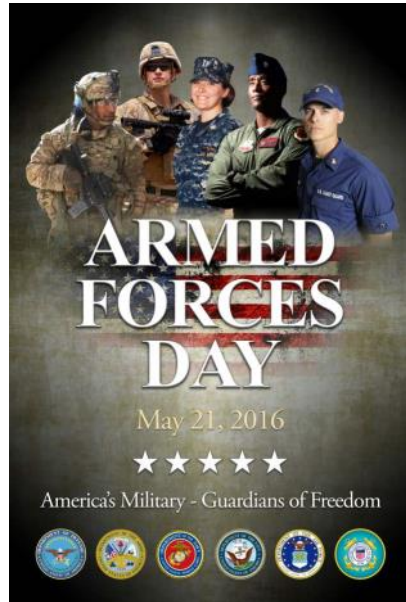
