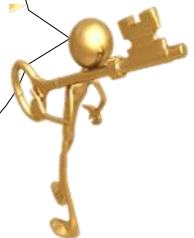

L.E.D. Lighting upgrade

The property committee recently approved a contract with Kane Electric, from Hackensack, to convert all the fluorescent tubes in fellowship hall, the kitchen, the two bathrooms, and the conference room with LED direct wired tubes. This should help save money on our electric bill and also be friendlier to the environment. The cost to have all the fixtures direct wired is \$4,000. This quote would include removing all the old ballasts and fluorescent tubes and providing and installing new commercial grade LED tubes .
