## Plants and Crafts

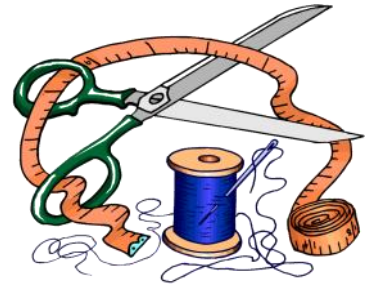
The Country Fair July 17th is a great place for you to bring some plant cuttings or garden décor. We'd also appreciate your crafts and wood working projects.
