Hurricane Damage to Florida Church

Suzy and Neil M., who live in Bradenton, FL in winter, had major damage to their church from Hurricane Helene. Water damage cleanup alone is \$225,000 The congregation has been worshipping in a senior center, and it needs a new roof. The hope of remodeling and repairing the church building is well beyond the financial ability of their 65-member congregation. Consequently, the congregation has voted to let the Synod take over the church, put it up for sale, and work with the council on future plans for the membership. Also, their interim pastor leaves in December, so please pray for their many decisions they will be making. FYI, Suzy and Neil's Florida property wasn't damaged, except for major tree damage.
